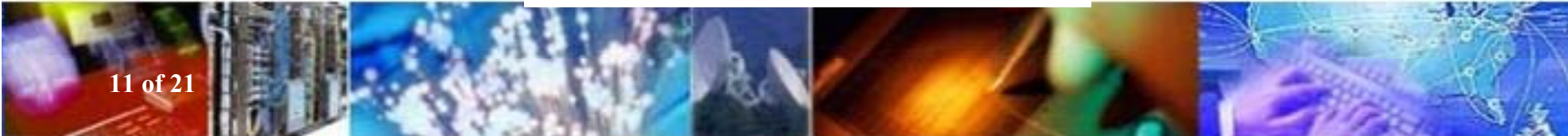
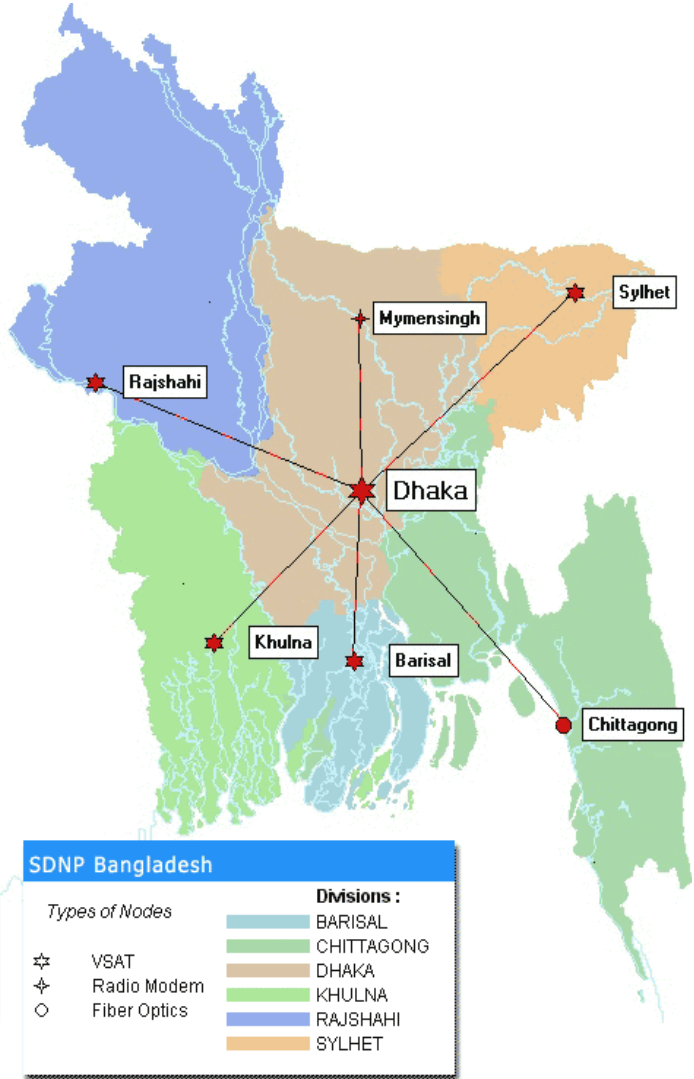

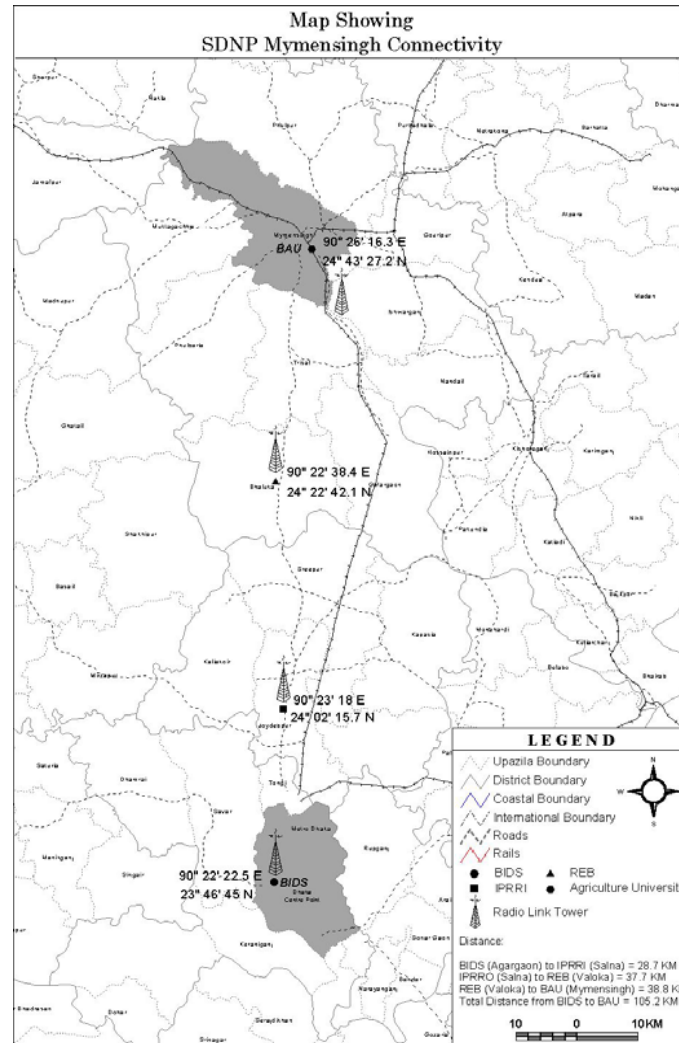

# SDNP COVERAGE



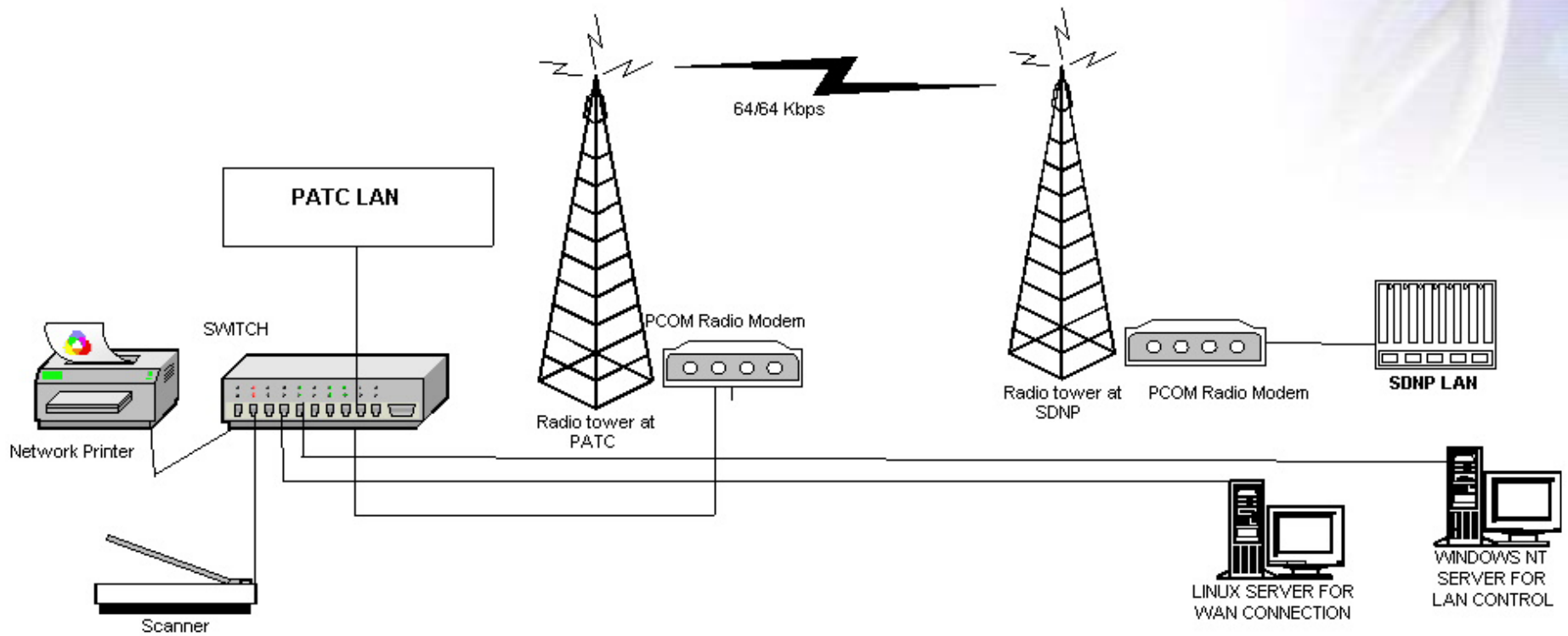
# SDNP MYMENSINGH LINK





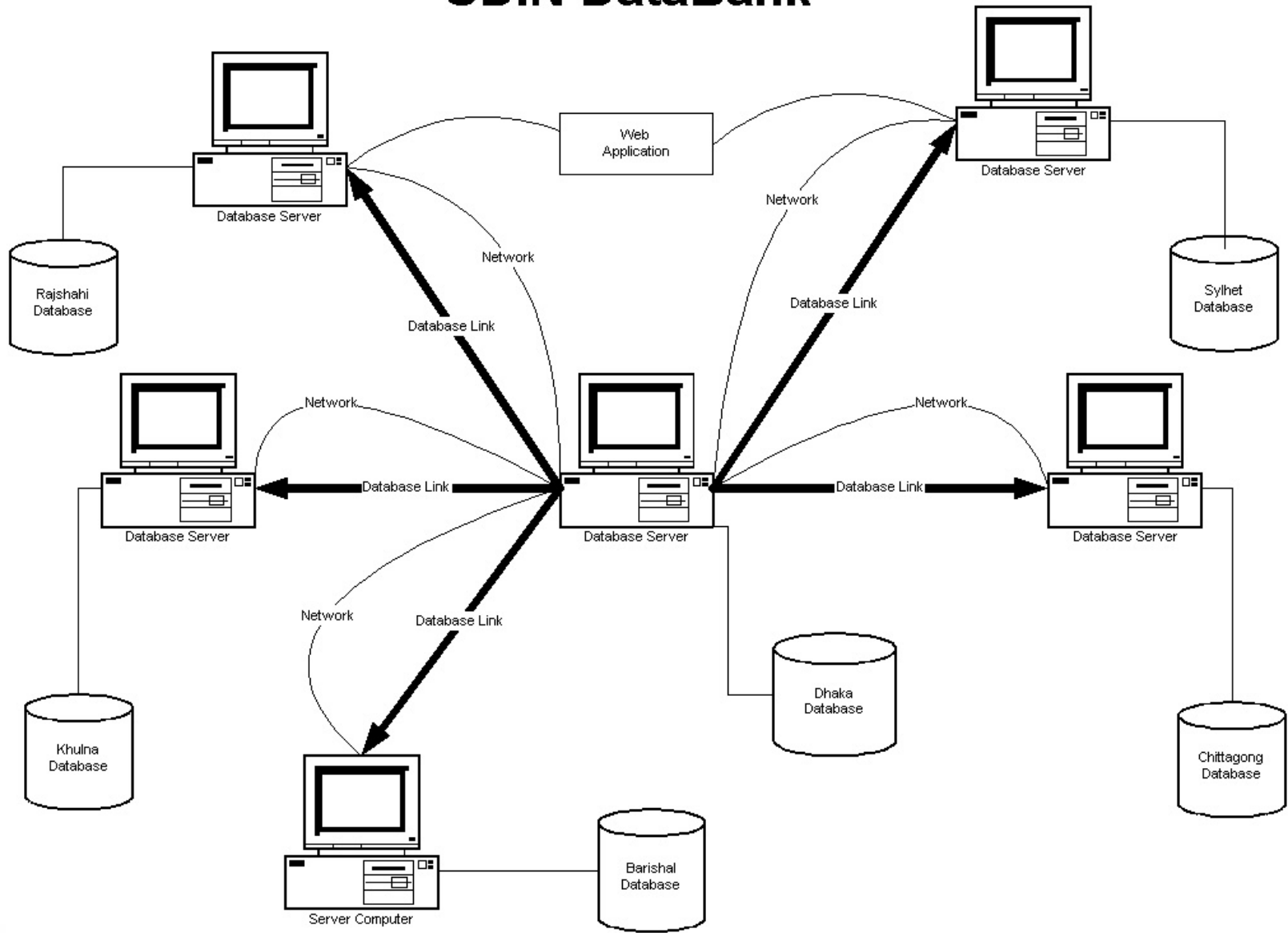
# SDNP PATC LINK
